

EXAMPLES of Corrections of ERRORS in COMPLETED Marriage Entries.

1. (a) **Discrepancy** between Col. 2 and the Signature of the Man, and (b) **omission of the Condition** of the Woman. Corrected by the Successor to the Clergyman who registered the Marriage.
