

Thomas Axton M. A. domestic Chaplain
to the Right Reverend Zachary Pearce
Lord Bishop of Rochester was collated
by his Lordship to the Vicarage of
Trendsbury on July 16th 1762; and came
to reside there on July 30th 1763.

Francis Snynton M. A. was collated
by the right rev. Zachary Pearce L.
Bishop of Rochester to the Vicarage of
Trendsbury the 24th day of March
1764. and came to reside at Grood the
24th of December following. His predecessor
of rev. M^r Axton died the 24th of
February 1764.

Robt. Fountaine M. A. minor Canon of the
Cathedral Church of Christ & the blessed Virgin
Mary, of Rochester was collated by the right
Rev. L^d Bishop of Rochester, to the Vicarage
of Trendsbury, for w^{ch} he resigned the
Vicarage of West Farleigh, to w^{ch} the Rev.
M^r Snynton was promoted by the Dean
& Chapter of Rochester, the 25th day of
January 1779 & undertook the ~~deat~~ care
of the parish the midsummer following.

William Philip Menzies M. A. Minor Canon
of Rochester was collated by the Right Rev. Lord
Bishop of Rochester to the Vicarage of Trendsbury
Jan^y 25. 1788.
