

EXAMPLES of Corrections of ERRORS in COMPLETED Marriage Entries.

1. (a) Discrepancy between Col. 2 and the Signature of the Man, and (b) omission of the Condition of the Woman. Corrected by the Successor to the Clergyman who registered the Marriage.
