

EXAMPLES of Corrections of ERRORS in COMPLETED Marriage Entries.

1. (a) Discrepancy between Col. 2 and the Signature of the Man; and (b) omission of the Condition of the Woman. Corrected by the Successor to the Clergyman who registered the Marriage.

1917. Marriage solemnized at the Parish Church, in the Parish of St. George, Hanover Square, in the County of London.

In Entry No. 78, Col. 2, for "Lional" read "Lional Henry"; and in Col. 1 below "1917" read "1916". "Splender" corrected on the 15 & 16 Apr. 1917, by me, James Richardson, Rector.

In the presence of { L. H. Brandon } & { Holly Maud Grindley } Married.

2. Error in Surname of the Man and of his Father and in the Man's Signature, discovered by Birth Certificate; the Parties Married having left the neighbourhood, but having requested a Correction, the Correction is made by the Clergyman in the presence of the Superintendent Registrar and two Witnesses, one of whom was the Man's Brother, the other having been present at the Marriage.

1917. Marriage solemnized at the Parish Church, in the Parish of Dorking, in the County of Surrey.

In Entry No. 32, Col. 8 and 7, and in the condition, for "Harber" read "Harwood"; corrected on the 15th February, 1918, by me, Montagu Curtis, Vicar.

3. The Man, of Illegitimate Birth, having been married in his reputed Name—that of his Putative Father—afterwards adopted his Maternal Surname.
